Vruwink won a seat on the State Assembly beginning in 2017 as a member of the



Democratic Party and currently serves on the Assembly's Agriculture, Education, Rural Development, and Tourism Committees. He was appointed by Governor Evers to the Dairy Task Force 2.0.
